Key megatrends such as:

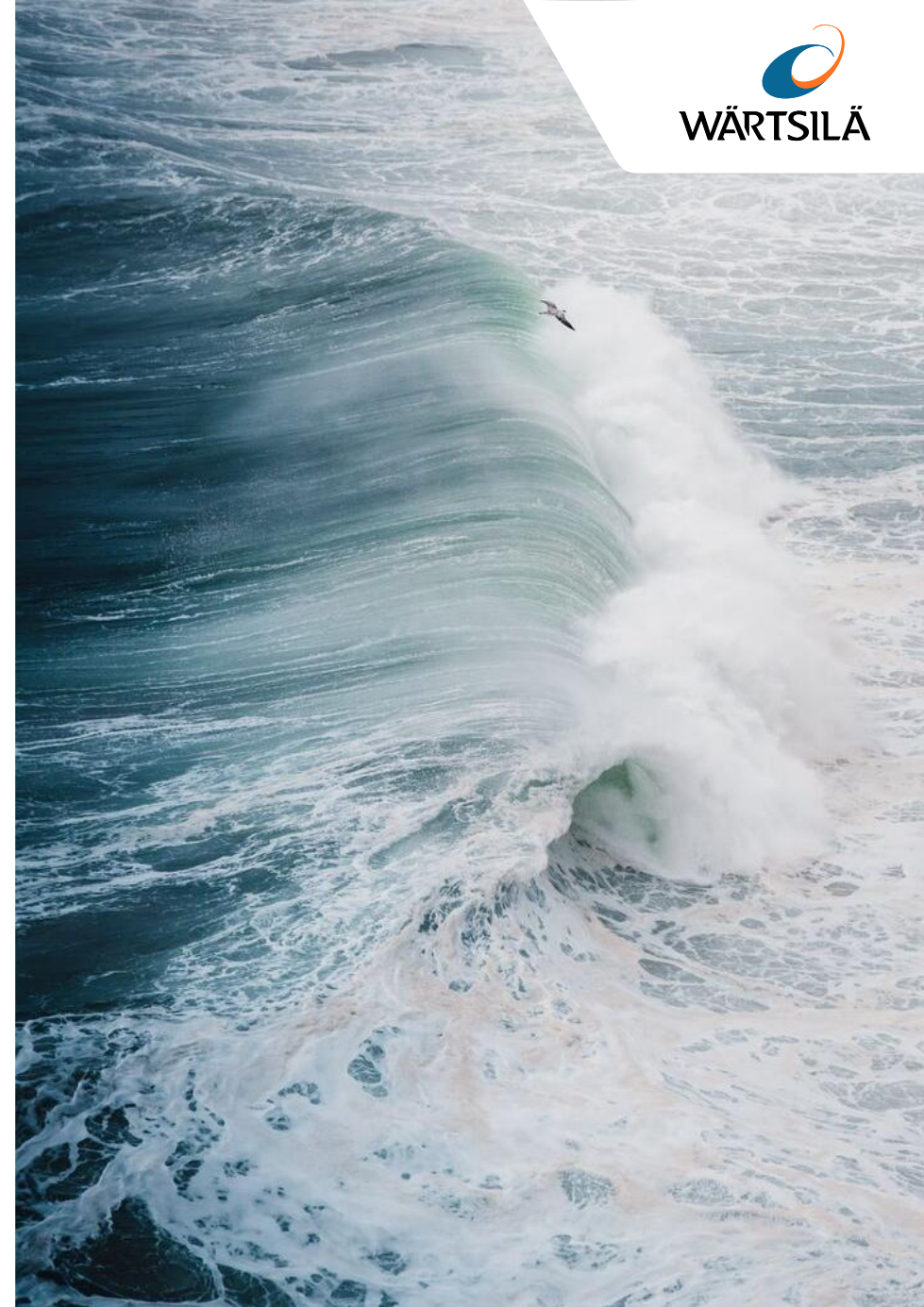
- Energy transition
